

# Medical Spanish Courses For High School Students: *Summer 2026*



## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

**This course is designed for** students already proficient in Spanish to learn medical terminology while refining their conversational skills. Since enabling students to connect with patients is our main goal, our classes are conversation and vocabulary driven. Terms and concepts related to intake; diagnostics; surgical and non-surgical interventions; treatment and therapy regimens; and recovery and rehabilitation are introduced and reinforced through practical role-playing scenarios, drills, games, and other activities. *Please note: we always encourage the use of professional medical interpreters during patient interactions.*

**Graduation Certificates:** Students who have successfully completed a course will receive a BMSC Certificate of Completion outlining the course topics and the hours completed.

## LOGISTICS

**Costs** of program (includes registration fee):

- All students: \$250
- Classes are capped at 8 and registrations are processed in the order in which they are received.

**Schedule:** Classes are held for one hour, twice per week

- **Times:** Sundays 9:00 - 10:00 am & Thursdays 7:00 - 8:00 pm (ET)
- **Course Dates:** June 28 - July 30 with make-up August 2 (in case a class is canceled for any reason)
- **All courses will be held online**
- The **registration deadline** is June 25. Read below to learn more.

## **Registration process**

1. Begin by completing the registration form. Your registration will be completed once your registration form and registration fee have been processed.
2. Schedule your placement interview. Telephone interviews are used to determine current Spanish proficiency and course level fit. These 15-minute calls are scheduled and conducted after registration.
3. After your placement interview, you will be placed into a course and invoiced for your remaining tuition. Your seat in the class is confirmed once your full tuition is received.

## DEADLINES AND REFUNDS

The **Registration Deadline** is the latest we generally cancel courses that are under-enrolled. In order to help ensure the success of a course, final tuition payments should be received by this date. However, it is still possible for students to register and enroll after the registration deadline, provided the course has not yet been closed.

**Registration fees** are deducted from the total tuition cost. They are NONREFUNDABLE unless the student does not place into one of the High School Medical Spanish courses for the cycle selected. The placement is determined by the placement interviews. Final tuition payments are fully refundable (minus the registration fee) until one month prior to the cycle's registration deadline. Students are considered fully enrolled once they have submitted their final tuition payment.

**Tuition payments** should be completed and received prior to the registration deadline in order to ensure a seat in a course and avoid forfeiture of one's registration fee. Fully enrolled students that need to unregister within one month of the registration deadline, but before the start of classes, can apply their tuition (minus the registration fee) to the next cycle.

## ADDITIONAL POLICIES

- All course materials will be shared directly with students over email or Google Classroom
  - Medical spanish admin will be cc'd in all communication (emails) between instructors, TA's, and Tutors
  - Parents/guardians may receive a copy of communications as well upon request
- Parents/ guardians are not to participate in class, even if in the same room as the student
- Class sessions will *not* be recorded
- The student phone number (required when registering) will only be used for the phone call interview. Medical Spanish admin will not contact a student via text or call for any other reason
